

Want to remove your tattoo permanently? Get laser tattoo removal in mumbai

However, time changes equations, social and professional requirements may very well demand the removal of these tattoos. This is where the hardest part comes in. Lasers fragment the pigmentation on the skin

A tattoo is formed as a result of pigmentation of various hues on the skin. A laser focuses its intense beam of light onto the targeted area. The specific wavelength of the light causes it to be absorbed by the ink on the tattoo. This triggers an action of breaking the pigmented area into smaller particles. Over a period of time and over repeated sessions the size of the fragments are progressively reduced till they reach a size where the body flushes it off the system completely.

Effectiveness depends on the colour of the tattoo and the laser used

Some colours are tough nuts to crack. It is relatively difficult to get rid of tattoos with colours of a particular spectrum, such as green and yellow. While other colours are flushed of the system easily, these colours are a lot more difficult. Experienced cosmetic surgeons from reputed centres rely on powerful lasers to tackle the difficult colours. However, the process is still the same, while the duration and the number of sessions may vary according to the tattoo.

Local anaesthesia to manage the associated pain

The gain from laser tattoo removal comes with a little bit of pain. However, it is performed with local anaesthesia to keep the pain under control. As it is a procedure involving application of external force on the skin in the form of intense light, you can expect blisters to form on the skin. However, these blisters will self-heal with time. The anaesthesia will give the surgeon proper access to targeted area without any form of interruption or involuntary reaction to pain.

Averaging eight sessions to separate you from the tattoo



The number of sessions required to take the tattoo off you would average around eight sessions, depending on the proficiency of the tattoo artist who put it on you. Professional tattoo artists use better quality ink and equipment for better results, which actually makes it difficult to remove. If you have received that mark of love, or an intricate design from an amateur tattoo artist, you are in luck. In about six sessions you can safely see off that tattoo. The time required between sessions is required to permit the skin to heal from the onslaught of the lasers to shatter the pigmentation.
